

20102 Delegation of Authority to President

The Board has the responsibility for both policy formation and the operation of the College. It may, however, by written order filed in its office, delegate to the President of the College any of the powers and duties vested in or imposed upon the Board by law, and the President thereupon shall exercise such powers and perform such duties in the name of the Board.

Any resolution, directive, provision of these Board Policies, or other act of the Board that authorizes the President to take action or otherwise delegates to the President any of the powers and duties vested in or imposed upon the Board by law with respect to any specific matter or issue, or with respect to any type of matter or issue, shall be deemed to be a written order filed in the office of the Board.

The President will establish a governance structure within the College which will enable the College's personnel to make recommendations for the formation of College Policy.
