MCC → UNMC

The Dentistry program must complete 90 semester hours prior to matriculation, however most students will have earned their bachelor's degree prior to applying to the College of Dentistry. Students can earn a bachelor's degree in any area of interest (i.e. biology, business, music, nursing, nutritional science). Listed below are Metropolitan Community College courses that satisfy the University of Nebraska Center's (UNMC) Dentistry admission requirements. UNMC publishes requirements for admission, general education, and major concentration areas. **Students should consult with their MCC Advisor and an UNMC advisor often.**
