Dear F-1 Student,

This letter is to inform you that Metropolitan Community College (MCC) has partnered with Academic HealthPlans (AHP) and Wellfleet to provide you with health insurance for the 2022-2023 academic year. There are no changes in coverage. We expect to receive the benefits summary and the master policy in the next couple of months. Once they are available, International Student Services will post them on the ISS website.

1. A co-pay will no longer be applied for primary care, specialist, or outpatient mental health visits.
2. In network services will be 80% of the negotiated charge after the deductible.
3. Out of network services will be 60% of the usual and customary after deductible.
4. If you will be continuing under the AHP-Wellfleet policy, you may purchase insurance for dependents for the 2022-2023 policy year.

You will need to pay the premium in full according to the chart below before registering for classes. No exceptions will be made for partial payment options. If you do not make the full payment, you will not be allowed to register for classes, which may result in your SEVIS record being terminated.

IMPORTANT: Students who enroll in Fall 2022 classes before the insurance hold has been applied to their account will need to pay the Fall and Winter 2022 insurance premium before Fall 2022 classes begin or risk the possibility of being dis-enrolled from those classes.
