Metropolitan Community College (MCC) will hold a solar installation seminar for industry trade, DIYs and those interested in learning more about solar.

The seminar will be at the Horticulture Greenhouse on the Fort Omaha Campus May 6–7, 2011. This is the first solar installation of its kind in the state, and the first in any community college greenhouse across the country.

Friday evening activities include a slide presentation and overview of the solar energy system. Saturday will include a tour of the greenhouse system and disassembly/re-assembly of the solar collector array.
