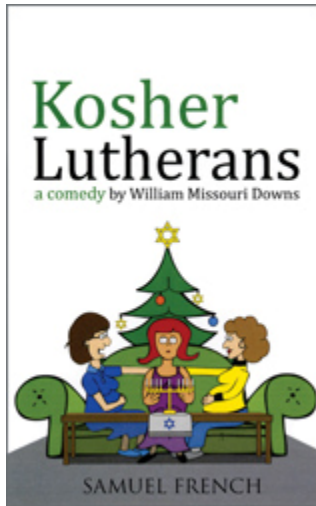


I've got two new comedies published by Samuel French.
