Award-Winning Playwright Emily Mann Scheduled for Great Plains Theatre Conference

(Omaha, Neb.) - Metropolitan Community College (MCC) announced that playwright and director Emily Mann will participate in the second annual *Great Plains Theatre Conference* May 26-June 4 at MCC's Fort Omaha Campus (30th and Fort Street).

During the Conference, Mann will participate as a panelist of the play labs, providing valuable feedback to aspiring playwrights. She will also host a master class on directing and be honored with an evening performance of a scene from her works.

Mann is celebrating her 17th season as the artistic director of McCarter Theatre in Princeton, N.J. A winner of the Dramatists' Guild Hull-Warriner Award, she is a member of the Dramatists Guild and serves on its council. In 2002, Mann received an Honorary Doctorate of Arts from Princeton University. Her directing credits include *All Over*, *The Glass Menagerie*, *Romeo and Juliet*, *Meshugah* and *Betsey Brown*. Her plays include the award-winning *Execution of Justice*, *Still Life* (six OBIE awards), *Greensboro: A Requiem* and *Annulla*. Mann wrote and directed *Having Our Say* (three Tony nominations, Drama Desk nominations, Joseph Jefferson and NAACP awards, Peabody and Christopher awards for the screenplay).
