### COURSE REGISTRATION

- Students must satisfy all course [prerequisite requirements](#) before registration can be processed.
- Students under the age of 16 are not eligible to enroll in ARTS 1110, ARTS 1120, ARTS 2010, CRIM (all courses), ENGL 2470, PHOT 1105, PSYC 1010, PSYC 1110, PSYC 1120, PSYC 2150, PSYC 2350, SOCI 2150, or VACA 2250.

25/FA = Fall Quarter, September 2 – November 17, 2025. **Registration opens May 8, 2025.**

25/WI = Winter Quarter, December 1, 2025 – February 23, 2026. **Registration opens September 25, 2025.**

25/SP = Spring Quarter, March 5 – May 20, 2026. **Registration opens January 16, 2026.**

26/SS = Summer Quarter, June 12 – August 22, 2026. **Registration opens March 26, 2026.**

**Dual Credit** allows students to earn both college and high school credit. College credits are not equivalent to high school credits and only the school district has authority to award high school credit.
