

40302 Student Academic Progress and Review of Academic Status

The College desires that every student have successful learning experiences. To facilitate successful completion of courses, students must fully participate in instructional activities. Assessment of the progress of students in completion of course objectives will be made by instructors. Academic progress will be measured both during the term and over contiguous terms of enrollment.

To encourage satisfactory progress throughout contiguous terms of enrollment the College adopts this academic progress policy. This policy establishes standards that must be met by all persons requesting to enroll in credit courses at the College. For specific definitions of Standards of Academic Progress see College catalog.

When students fail to maintain satisfactory academic progress, the College may restrict the number of credit hours for which they may enroll in a quarter and may establish other special conditions under which they may enroll, including, but not limited to, regular meetings with counselors and advisors, enrollment in developmental courses and the career development program, and completing assessment tests.

Recognizing that there may be extenuating circumstances from time to time which may warrant a review of a student's academic progress, the President shall establish procedures for requesting the review of the application of academic standards of progress and shall notify students of the procedures through appropriate publications and methods.
