## 50202 Admission Requirements for Programs

Enrollment into the College does not guarantee acceptance of an individual student into a particular course or program.

All students are expected to seek education and career goal advisement upon admission/enrollment into the College through the Enrollment or Student Services staff. Students will be placed in approved courses and programs according to their demonstrated needs and proficiencies. Recent high school graduates will be requested to provide the College with high school transcripts and any available test scores in order to determine proper course and program placement. A Compass test, or recent ACT score, is required for courses when a minimum competency in math, writing or reading is required.

The College President may approve the adoption of special admission requirements for particular courses or programs in addition to the general admission requirements of the College.

The President may identify programs in which the College receives more applications than available College resources can accommodate. These may be identified as high demand programs and early quarterly enrollment by students and the establishment of minimum criteria and qualifications for admission may be implemented.
