

60503 Activities Outside the Scope of Employment

Community Activities: College personnel are encouraged to participate actively in community organizations and activities. When memberships are deemed to be extremely beneficial to the College, including when memberships promote the College's commitment to valuing diversity, the President may authorize College funds to pay the annual dues to organizations for College personnel. (Amended 12/17/96)

On-going Outside Employment: Outside employment by a College full-time professional staff member may be permitted providing it does not affect his or her regular duties and responsibilities at the College. Request for such consideration must be made through proper channels to the President.

Tutoring: An employee may do private tutoring, but may not tutor Metropolitan Technical Community College students for pay.
