MCC, DiVentures teaming up for Open Water Scuba Diving

OMAHA, Neb. — Metropolitan Community College is offering an entry level course designed toward a career path as a diving professional, including five industry certifications through the Open Water Scuba Diving course held at DiVentures, 4303 S. 121st Plaza.

Students will explore areas of safety, equipment, stabilization, recovery basics and rescue tools and extraction.

“This course is valuable to those in the emergency services field.” said Peggy Dean, emergency management program director for emergency medical training at MCC. “Students will learn all the basics while either prepping for a career as a dive professional or earn valuable career certificates.”

The course will take place during the College’s Fall Quarter on Tuesdays and Thursdays, 8 a.m.–noon, beginning Sept. 8.
