- It is recommended that students complete the courses in the Associate in Science degree above within two years, and no more than five years. Courses transferred after five years are individually reviewed.
- The College of Nursing admits approximately 75 students into Omaha, 72 students into Lincoln, 48 into Kearney and Norfolk, and 36 students into Western Nebraska divisions in the fall of each year. Admission into the College of Nursing is competitive. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required. Admission preference is given to students with GPAs of 3.3 and above
- Complete of all the required courses does not guarantee admission into the College of Nursing. Every effort
 has been made to provide accurate information on suggested courses; however, it is the student's
 responsibility to consult with the institution they are planning to transfer to ensure courses fit into their
 intended plan of study. For additional information on course-by-course equivalencies please contact the

- As per UNMC requirements, students must have a grade no lower than "B" in any individual prerequisite course. A maximum of 12 semester hours (18 quarter hours) can be non-graded (audited)."
