Metropolitan Community College's Library subscribes to 30+ databases containing eBooks, streaming videos, and full-text articles from magazines, newspapers, and academic journals. These databases cover a wide range of topics: current political and social issues, business, careers, computer science, criminal justice, law, education, health and medicine, horticulture, management, psychology, science, sociology, vocational/technical trades, and more. *To access a research database from home, you must be a current MCC student, faculty, or staff member and you must know your MCC <u>username & password</u>.*

- 1. Go to the Library's webpage: <u>www.mccneb.edu/library</u>
- 2. Click on the tab labeled **Databases**
- 3. Use the **Title** menu to select a database
- 4. Enter your username and password:
 - Enter the same username/password you use to access Canvas, MyWay, or to sign on to a MCC computer or the MCC network.
 - Enter only your username not your complete email address. Example: jsmith NOT jsmith@mail.mccneb.edu
 - If you do not know your username/password, go to Password Reset:
 www.mccneb.edu/password
