

## Transfer Guide – Physician Assistant

### MCC → UNMC

The Physician Assistant program is a master's level program that requires students to complete a bachelor's degree. Students can earn a bachelor's degree in any area of interest (i.e. Biology, Business, Music, Nursing, etc.). Listed below are Metropolitan Community College courses that satisfy the University of Nebraska Center's (UNMC) Physician Assistant (PA) admission requirements. UNMC publishes requirements for admission, general education, and major concentration areas. **Students should consult with their MCC Advisor and an UNMC advisor often.**
