Program Admission Criteria

Admissions are selective and competitive. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 to be considered for admission with the most qualified applicants being admitted. Applicants are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- Cumulative GPA
- Math/Science GPA
- Fulfillment of program technical standards
