# Certificate to Bachelor Articulation Agreement

Nebraska Methodist College provides a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree completion program in a traditional, semester format. The program enrolls students each fall and spring semester. The courses below are eligible for transfer to NMC but are not prerequisites.

**Admission Criteria to Nebraska Methodist College:**

- Proof of LPN licensure or proof of eligibility for LPN licensure if student is a new graduate.
- Graduate of an accredited or state approved LPN program
- Proof of successful completion of program pre-requisites: Algebra, Biology and Chemistry (high school or college)
