Program Admission Criteria

ST enrolls for an August or January start. Please work directly with an NMC Admissions counselor to determine best start date. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be considered for admission. Applicants are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- High school record
- ACT composite of 20 or above or SAT 950 critical reading and mathematics score (if within 2 years of high school graduation)
- Demonstration of success in previous math and science courses (Recommended but not required courses: Algebra, Biology, Chemistry and Anatomy & Physiology)
- College Record
- Fulfillment of program technical standards
