### Program Admission Criteria

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be considered for admission. Admissions are competitive and applicants are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- High school record
- ACT composite 20 or above or SAT 950 critical reading and mathematics scores (if within 2 years of high school graduation)
- College record
- No specific prerequisites, however, the following Math and science courses are recommended: Algebra, Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology and Physics
- Fulfillment of program technical standards\*\*
- Shadowing experience strongly recommended and documentation may be submitted with application\*\*
