



# Respiratory Care Associate of Science Program (AS or BS)

## General Education Transfer Guide

Nebraska Methodist College offers a two year Associate degree in Respiratory Care. Many NMC students are transfer students from MCC who have completed a few of the courses below. The Respiratory courses specifically only begin once a year in May but applications are accepted all year and student may be able to complete the degree in three semesters. Contact NMC Admissions to set up an appointment to review your Metro transcripts and we will help you determine when is the best time to start and if pursuing our associate degree or bachelor degree is the best for you. ### Program Admission Criteria

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be considered for admission. Applicants are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- High school record
- ACT composite 20 or above or SAT 950 critical reading and mathematics scores (if within 2 years of high school graduation)
- College record
- Math and science courses (recommended courses Algebra, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Medical Terminology)
- Encouraged to shadow a professional in a respiratory care department
- Fulfillment of program technical standards

Upon completion of the Associate degree, NMC graduates are eligible to enroll in one of two Bachelor degree completion options: Bachelor of Science in Health Studies with a major in Respiratory Care. Graduates from MCC's Respiratory care program are also eligible to apply for these degrees.
