### Notes

- The Respiratory Therapy program is an 11-month program that is divided into 3 semesters plus an inter-term. Courses start in August and are taught at Alegent Creighton Health, Omaha, NE.
- 120 semester hours are required for a Bachelor's Degree in Respiratory Therapy. (RET courses = 48)
- The requirements for a bachelor degree at Midland University must be met before a degree is awarded. To complete the bachelor degree, students typically complete three college years at MCC or MU, then complete the Respiratory Therapy Program their senior year.
- A maximum of 108 quarter / 72 semester hours are transferable to Midland University from MCC.
- Additional coursework in MCC's general education is helpful both in transfer to MU toward the bachelor's degree and in academic preparation for the Respiratory Therapy Program. Refer to the online Institutional Core Requirements Transfer Guide

### Application Notes

All students applying for admission to the Respiratory Therapy School must meet the following requirements.

- **Completion of all degree requirements with the exception of the Respiratory (RET) courses.**  
 Degree requirements can be completed by:
  - \* Taking all courses in residence at Midland University, or
  - \* Transferring up to 72 credit hours from MCC or other accredited institution with approval of the registrar.
  - \* Transferring the credits from an earned degree. The agreement between MCC and Midland University states that any student transferring to MU with an earned associate's transfer degree (AA or AS) will be accepted as having completed all MU general education requirements.
- Application deadline is August 1st. Please allow adequate time for financial aid application and processing.
- Completion of all the courses listed above **does not guarantee** admission to the Respiratory Therapy program.
- The program admits 10 – 15 students each year. Admission into the Respiratory Therapy program is very competitive. The following are considered for admission:
  - Minimum overall GPA of 3.0 to be competitive
  - Interview with admissions committee
  - Volunteer work, activities, work experience and good references
