Dear MCC F-1 Student,

International Student Services (ISS) hopes you are doing well this Spring Quarter. Summer Quarter will be here before we know it, and we want to send you a reminder. Summer Quarter is not an automatic vacation. If you are in status and have completed three quarters consecutively, you may request a vacation. To request a vacation quarter, please print the "Vacation Request" form at <https://www.mccneb.edu/Prospective-Students/Resources/International/International-Student-Services-Forms.aspx>. Please fill it out, and then email it to ISS at [iss@mccneb.edu](mailto:iss@mccneb.edu) for review. Wait for ISS to inform you if your request is approved or denied. Please note that you are required to pay for insurance, even if you are on vacation because you have an I-20 from MCC.

If approved, you are welcome to take classes during vacation, and you may leave or stay in the U.S.. If you are leaving, ask ISS to sign page two of your newest I-20 under "Travel Endorsement". U.S. Customs and Border protection will look for the signature when you re-enter the US. Upon return, please give ISS a copy of your new I-94 and admission stamp. If you renewed your visa or passport, please also provide copies.

If you are required to enroll full time in the Summer Quarter, you may continue to count one online course towards full time enrollment. MCC has some courses offered during two five-week sessions. You may not enroll in only one of the five-week sessions. **Your schedule may consist of online or five-week session classes, but your schedule must show that you are enrolled on campus during June 6 - August 15, 2019.** ESL courses are only offered on campus in the ten-week session.

MCC's Summer Quarter 2019 schedule is as follows:

Ten-week session	June 6 – August 15
First five-week session	June 6 – July 11
Second five-week session	July 12 – August 15
