

PN COMPREHENSIVE PREDICTOR 2017 EXAM

PURPOSE: This exam is only for applicants applying to the nursing department's LPN-Certified (LPN-C) program. Applicants must hold a current LPN license and are trying to get into the RN program. Students do not have to be a current MCC student or have taken any previous courses at MCC to take this examination.

FROM ATI TESTING: This 180-item test offers an assessment of the student's comprehension and mastery of basic principles including fundamentals of nursing, pharmacology, adult medical surgical nursing, maternal newborn care, mental health nursing, nursing care of children, nutrition, and management. The percentage of questions on each assessment correlates with NCLEX®-PN client need categories as represented on the 2017 NCLEX-PN Detailed Test Plan. These major categories include Safe and Effective Care Environment, Health Promotion and Maintenance, Psychosocial Integrity, and Physiological Integrity. This test will generate the following data: Individual Score (% Correct), Predicted Probability to Pass NCLEX-PN, National and Program Means, Individual Scores (% Correct) within Content Topic Categories, Topics to Review, and Individual Scores (% Correct) within an Outcome (Thinking Skills, Nursing Process, Priority Setting, NCLEX-PN Client Need Categories, Clinical Areas, QSEN, and NLN Competencies).

TEST PARAMETERS: This is a computer based test. Students receive full score reports within minutes of completing their exam.

TIME LIMIT: Students have 180 min (3 hours) to complete this assessment.

MATERIALS ALLOWED: Scratch Paper and Pencil

Calculator. A calculator is built into ATI's website. A 4-function hand-held calculator may be used for DSS accommodations or technical issues only.

FEE: \$60

Before testing, you must create an account with ATI to set up your "*Username and Password*".

YOU WILL NEED YOUR ATI USERNAME AND PASSWORD TO TAKE YOUR TEST.

2. Click "CREATE AN ACCOUNT" at the top of the webpage.
3. As you complete the **USER INFORMATION** page, be sure to select "**METROPOLITAN CC ADN NE**" from the "INSTITUTION" information drop down box.
4. When finished entering your information click "**REGISTER.**"

Retake policy:

All applicants must wait at least 30 days before retaking the PN Comprehensive Predictor and it may only be retaken twice within a three year period. A retake must also be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance to testing and students must convey to Testing Center Staff that they are requesting to take a retake. **The cost for each retake to be taken is \$60.**
